2. **ANY 2017-2018 AHSRA Contestant** may enter and participate in the State Finals Rodeo as long as they have completed the following “Condition of Membership” Requirements:
  - (A) Turned in a minimum of \$300 in ads or sponsorships
  - (B) Paid any outstanding fines or fees
  - (C) Sold a minimum of 4 drawdown tickets
  - (D) Submitted an acceptable grade report (turned in before date of finals Mandatory meeting)

\*Contestants failing to meet any of the above requirements will not be allowed to enter and compete at the 2018 AHSRA State Finals.

3. **STATE FINALS ENTRY FORM;** MUST be turned in or postmarked by May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2018 for regular entry. Any late entries received/postmarked between May 7<sup>th</sup> and May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2018 will receive a \$25 late fine. If late fine is not paid with entry form, it will be collected at check in, CASH ONLY! No entries will be accepted if postmarked after May 11<sup>th</sup>, 2018. **Get your forms in on time! NO events will be added after May 11<sup>TH</sup>, 2018. NO faxed forms will be accepted. NO REFUNDS AND NO EXCEPTIONS.**

**MINOR'S RELEASE, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT**

We, the undersigned, hereby request that the below named minor (minor) be granted permission (1) to enter the restricted area, (2) to participate as a contestant, assistant, official or otherwise in rodeo events, (3) to compete for money, prizes, recognition or reward, (4) to be covered by participants' hospitalization insurance, in applicable, as limited by the master policy (all collectively hereinafter called "permissive entry").

In consideration of "permissive entry" to minor into the restricted area, which is the area from which admission to the general public is restricted, which includes, but is not limited to the rodeo arena, competition area, chutes, pens, adjacent walkways, concessions, and other appurtenances, we the undersigned, on behalf of the minor and for ourselves, or personal representative, heirs, next of kin, spouses and assigns, do hereby:

1. RELEASE, DISCHARGE AND COVENANT NO TO SUE the rodeo committee, stock contractor, rodeo association, sponsors, arena operators or owners, and each of them, their officers, agents and employees (all hereinafter collectively referred to as "releases") from any and all claims and liability arising out of strict liability or ordinary negligence of releases or any other participant which causes the undersigned injury, death, damages or property damage. We, the undersigned, jointly severally, and in common covenant to hold releases harmless and to indemnify releases from any claim, judgment or expenses releases may incur arising out of any of the minor's activities or presence in the restricted area.
2. UNDERSTAND that the minor's entry into the restricted area and/or the participation in rodeo events contains CANGER AND RISK OF INJURY OR DEATH TO MIONR, that conditions of the rodeo arena change from time to time and may become more hazardous, that rodeo animals are dangerous and unpredictable, and that there is INHERENT DANGER in rodeo which we appreciate and voluntarily assume because the minor and we choose to do so. Each of the undersigned has observed events of the type that the minor seeks to participate in. We further understand that the arena surface, access ways or lack thereof, lighting or lack thereof, and weather conditions all change and pose a danger to the minor. We further understand that other contestants and participants pose a danger to the minor's entry into the restricted area and/or participation in any rodeo events.
3. AGREE that this agreement shall apply to any incident, injury, accident or death occurring on the above date and FOR A PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR THEREAFTER or until the minor's association membership expires, whichever shall last occur. All subsequent agreements release documents signed by any of the undersigned shall amplify, but shall in no way limit the provision of this document. The provisions of this document may be cancelled by any one of the undersigned by delivering to the above rodeo association written cancellation of this agreement which shall be effective 24 hours after the date said cancellation is actually received by the rodeo association.
4. Releaser or parents or guardians of the undersigned minor AGREE TO INDEMNIFY the Releases and each of them from an loss, ability, damage or costs they may incur due to the presence or participation of the minor in the described activities whether caused by the negligence of the Releases or otherwise.

WE HAVE READ THIS DOCUMENT, WE UNDERSTAND IT IS A RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS. WE APPRECIATE AND ASSUME ALL RISKS INHERENT IN RODEO.

## CONTESTANT GRADES DUE AT STATE FINALS

TO COMPETE AT THE 2018 AHSRA STATE FINALS RODEO, YOU MUST TURN IN YOUR FINAL END OF THE YEAR GRADES BEFORE OR AT CHECK-IN ON JUNE 6<sup>TH</sup> AT THE MANDATORY MEETING. IF YOU DO NOT HAVE YOUR GRADES AT CHECK-IN, **YOU WILL NOT RODEO.**

A copy of your end of the year final grades (six week/nine week/other) must be turned in before you can rodeo at State Finals. The latest they will be accepted will be at check-in at State Finals.

It is recommended to check with your school EARLY to find out when your grades will be issued. If your school mails your grades to you and they will not reach you in time, you must take the note below to your school official. Explain to your school official why you must have your grades. Have them type your grades on school letterhead and then have a school official sign and date them. Turn in this letter as a substitute for your report card at check-in only if your grades will not reach you in time. It is your responsibility to get your grade or the signed grade letter, and to have them available at check-in at State Finals on June 6<sup>TH</sup>, 2018.

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## 2018 AHSRA Cowboy Prom Rules/Contract

AHSRA is excited to be hosting a "Cowboy Prom" as our kick-off social event for 2018 State Finals. We plan on this being a very special evening for all who attend. Attendance is voluntary. There will be no cost to contestants for this event. Mr. Brent Davenport has agreed to be our DJ for the night and a photographer will be available for pictures. Check the state finals schedule of events for start time.

To ensure that everyone has the opportunity to enjoy the prom, we will enforce the following rules:

1. Appropriate dress is required for all who attend. This includes contestants and any guest they bring. **Young men** are expected to wear dress shirts, clean jeans or dress pants, boots or other dress shoes. This means a shirt that buttons down the front and has a collar. This can be a western shirt or more formal shirt such as Sunday attire. Tuxedo, ties, jackets, etc. are not required but may be worn. Shirt must remain on and tucked in the entire dance. **Young ladies** may wear semi-formal, formal dresses or dressy skirts and blouses, semi-formal pantsuit or dressy shirt and nice jeans. Boots and other dress shoes will be allowed. Dresses must be no shorter than fingertip length. Full midriffs must be covered. The neckline must not plunge low. Backs may not be lower than the natural waistline. No see-through material and slits in dress may not be higher than fingertip length. **The following will not be acceptable by men or ladies:** shorts, tank tops, t-shirts, tennis shoes, flip flops, jeans with holes, etc. The board and chaperones have the right to refuse admittance to anyone not having appropriate dress.
2. Those who attend the cowboy prom are expected to behave in a mature, dignified manner. Music selections being played must be appropriate for a high school prom. Any music that implies promiscuous sexual activity or explicit lyrics including, but not limited to, extreme violence and foul language or profanity will not be permitted. Contestants and guest are asked to dance appropriately. Any dancing that implies promiscuous sexual activity is prohibited.
3. All NHSRA and AHSRA rules and guidelines are in effect during the Cowboy Prom. This includes policies regarding drugs, alcohol, and tobacco products.
4. Contestants will be allowed to bring one guest with them. Each contestant is responsible for his/her guest. The guest does not have to be an AHSRA contestant. Contestants State Finals back #'s will be required to enter prom. Contestants will be required to sign themselves and guest in at entrance to prom and back # will be turned in. Contestant back #'s will be returned as he/she leave the prom. Once a contestant and guest enter the prom, they must remain in the building until ready to leave the prom. You will not be allowed to re-enter. No contestant will be allowed to enter after 8:00 pm.
5. The Cowboy Prom is being held in hopes of many positive memories being made for all that attend. Misbehavior by any individual will not be tolerated. Anyone unable to comply with the above rules will be denied admission, could be asked to leave, parents contacted, and could result in disqualification from rodeo activities.

I/we agree to abide by the above Cowboy Prom Rules and understand the consequences if I do not obey the rules. Students and guest who refuse to comply with request by chaperones to refrain from inappropriate dancing and/or behavior will be asked to leave the dance by one of the chaperones or directors. Admittance to the cowboy prom will not be allowed without this form properly signed by contestant and parent.
