2018-2019 CONTESTANT CONTRACT

Contestants: As a condition of membership in the AHSRA, each contestant must meet the following requirements:

1. **Finals Ad Book/Sponsorship Sales**- Every contestant must sell a minimum of \$300.00 in ads or sponsorships or a combination thereof.
 - a. Finals Ad Book sales must be received by Ad Secretary, Tracy Henderson, by the deadline dates listed below:
 - i. First Deadline: One of the attached forms and a minimum of \$150 in sales are due at the December Rodeo or date equivalent.
 - ii. Second Deadline: One of the attached forms and the balance \$150 (or more) in sales are due at the March Rodeo or date equivalent.
 - b. Your sales responsibility may be sold through ads, awards, sponsorship, etc.
 - c. There will be a \$25.00 per rodeo weekend late fee for any deadlines not met. You will not be eligible to rodeo until ad/sponsor sales are met.
 - d. You are responsible for collecting and mailing any ads or sponsorships sold along with either of the forms attached including pictures, business cards, etc to complete ads which will not be returned. These forms, ad, and sponsorships can be emailed to tracyhenderson627@gmail.com or mailed to Tracy Henderson, 5812 Abba lane, Pensacola, FL 32526, (770) 313-2244.
 - e. You must include contestant's name and back number on all the checks, ads, and forms to receive credit for the ads sold.
 - f. Complete the State Sponsorship form and/or Finals Ad Book Form with each sale.
 - g. **Finals Ad Book Sales Sponsor Incentive Program**: Any contestant selling additional ad/sponsor money as indicated below will receive incentive money, stalls, and/or hook ups at State Finals. Not to be paid out until State Finals.
 - i. \$1000 in sales-Contestant will receive \$300 at State Finals and one free finals pass
 - ii. \$2000 in sales-Contestant will receive \$300, one free finals pass, one stall, and one hook up at State Finals
 - iii. \$3000 in sales-Contestant will receive \$400 at State Finals and one free finals pass
 - iv. \$4000 in sales-Contestant will receive \$400, one free finals pass, one stall, and one hook up at State Finals
 - v. \$5000 in sales-Contestant will receive \$500 at State Finals and one free finals pass

- vi. \$6000 in sales-Contestant will receive \$500, one free finals pass, one stall, and one hook up at State Finals
 - vii. \$7500 in sales-Contestant will receive \$750, two free finals pass, one hook up, and stalls for each event entered at State Finals
 - viii. \$10000 in sales-Contestant will receive \$1500, three free finals pass, one hook up, and stalls for each event entered at State Finals
 - ix. Ad/Sponsorship money donated directly to the Association, not to a student, shall not be calculated towards a student's totals.
2. **Drawdown Ticket Sales**- Every contestant must sell a minimum of four (4) drawdown tickets. Each ticket is \$100.00.
- a. Drawdown tickets must be received by Drawdown Secretary, Amy Kent, by the deadline dates listed below:
 - i. First Deadline: Two tickets or a minimum of \$200 in tickets are due at the December Rodeo or date equivalent.
 - ii. Second Deadline: Two tickets or the balance \$200 (or more) in tickets are due at the March Rodeo or date equivalent.
 - b. Drawdown dinner will be held at Alabama High School Finals with date to be announced.
3. **Family Work Hours**- Every contestant family must work a minimum of 10 hours annually at an AHSRA rodeo/function/cutting or other assignment that volunteer help is needed.
- a. The hours are per family not per contestant.
 - b. There will be opportunities for all families to sign up for these hours in and out of the arena, including but not limited to event directors, door entry, concessions, grounds/arena help, committees and event set up.
 - c. All work hours must be completed by the end of the last regular season rodeo.
 - d. If a family chooses not to work the hours or fails to work the hours, the family must pay \$200 with their finals entry to be eligible to compete in the state finals rodeo.

The above requirements are the contestants' responsibility and must be met prior to competing at state finals. Each contestant and their parents acknowledge and agree that they are committed to the above requirements.
